

Subject: Child Development

Curriculum intent:

This KS4 qualification allows students to develop their knowledge and understanding of child development and growth of children up to the age of five, how children learn through play and how meeting the needs of individual children will support their development.

In a practical learning environment, students will have the opportunity to develop applied knowledge in the following areas:

- the characteristics of children's development from birth up to five years
- factors that affect growth and development
- the importance of play
- how play promotes children's learning and development
- reasons why children may need support
- child-friendly environments to support play, learning and development in children from birth to five years old
- supporting all children to learn and develop physically, intellectually, emotionally and socially, and adapting activities to support children's play, learning and development.
