Dear Parent or Carer,

As you will be aware, schools were instructed to close to everyone, except children of key workers and vulnerable children. We have remained in regular contact with families who are keyworkers and those who are identified as vulnerable (with an allocated social worker and those with Education, Health and Care Plans) to determine whether provision is required for these students over the Easter holidays.

We can now confirm that we have no planned pupils attending Hazel Wood High School over Easter. To enable staff to remain at home, as per Government advice, a decision has been made to close the school building for Easter.

We intend to reopen School on Monday 20th April for children of key workers and vulnerable children where prior arrangements have been made with the school for their children to attend. This decision will be reviewed and finalised to take into account Government advice which is due to be reviewed in the next week or so.

Please remember, that current Government advice is that many parents who work within critical sectors should try and ensure their child is kept at home. Every child who can be safely cared for at home should be, to limit the chance of the virus spreading. The health and safety of our pupils, staff and families remain a key consideration.
