Using the Arbor Parent App

Hazel Wood uses **Arbor** as its central system for managing student information and school administration. We kindly ask all parents and carers to ensure they are actively using the Arbor Parent Portal or App to stay informed and up to date.

Through Arbor, you can:

- Access attendance, assessment and progress data
- See exam timetables and results
- Receive school communications
- View your child's timetable

Road Safety and Parking

I would like to remind all parents and carers of the importance of driving and parking safely around the school site. There have been increasing concerns about vehicles travelling too fast past the school gates and parking on double yellow lines, which poses a serious risk to our students, staff, and other families.

Please help us keep everyone safe by:

- **Reducing speed** when approaching and leaving the school.
- Avoiding parking on double yellow lines, zigzag markings, in front of traffic cones or in front of driveways.
- Consider dropping off/picking up away from school

We understand that these times of day can be busy, but safety must come first. We are working closely with local authorities to monitor the situation and may involve enforcement officers if necessary.

Mobile Phone Use

Below is a summary of the school's policy on student mobile phones:

- **Emergency Use Only:** Students may bring mobile phones to school strictly for emergencies. Phones must be switched off and kept securely, such as in a blazer pocket.
- **Permission Required:** If a student needs to use their phone during the school day, they must seek permission from a member of staff.
- Misuse Consequences:
 - o First Offence: Phone may be collected at the end of the day.
 - Repeated Misuse: Parents/Carers may be asked to collect the phone, and the student may be required to hand it in daily for a fixed period.

Important Note for Parents/Carers:

Please refrain from contacting your child directly via their mobile phone during the school day. Instead, contact the school office or your child's Pastoral Year Leader.
