Industrial Action – Thursday 27th April & Tuesday 2nd May

Dear Parent/Carer,

A thorough risk assessment has been completed for the third set of teacher strike action dates, Thursday 27th April and Tuesday 2nd May. The outcome of this risk assessment is that we can remain partially open on both days. Detailed below are the year groups that can attend school and arrangements for those that cannot.

Year Group	Detail
Year 7	<u>School is closed to this year group</u> but independent study tasks & lessons will be provided on TEAMS. Students are expected to complete these tasks.
Year 8	<u>School is closed to this year group</u> but independent study tasks & lessons will be provided on TEAMS. Students are expected to complete these tasks.
Year 9	<u>School is closed to this year group</u> but independent study tasks & lessons will be provided on TEAMS. Students are expected to complete these tasks.
Year 10	School is open normal hours for <u>targeted students of vocational subjects only</u> . Your child has been made aware of this and will bring separate correspondence from our subject leads to confirm this is the case for them. For the remainder of the year group, School is closed but independent study tasks & lessons will be provided on TEAMS. Students are expected to complete these tasks.
Year 11	School is open normal hours

Please note that we have changed the year groups for these two Industrial Action days. Due to the proximity to the start of the summer exam period we have had to prioritise our Year 11 year group as well as those in Year 10 whose vocational coursework counts towards their final exam grade.

If you have a child in Year 7 that you are unable to arrange supervision for, as you are a key worker; or if your Year 7 child is particularly vulnerable for any reason, please contact us and we will see if we can facilitate a supervised place in school for them. This will be decided on a case-by-case basis and will only be provided in exceptional circumstances, as we have significantly lower staff than usual. To ask for a place, please contact Mrs Davison - our KS3 Director - or Miss Rothwell, our Pastoral Year Leader for Year 7.

Mrs. Wood, our SENCO, will also be in contact with those students who have a EHCP (regardless of year group) to offer them a place in school if needed.

I realise that this means that some of you will have to make alternative arrangements for your child at short notice. I understand that this situation is frustrating and I ask that all members of our community continue to support each other and treat each other with respect. Hazel Wood remains committed to providing a safe and secure environment for our pupils.

If you have any questions please see the information below and if your question remains unanswered please do not hesitate to contact school. School will return to normal operating procedures on Wednesday 3rd May when we look forward to having all year groups back in school for an 8.45am start.
